Basic Specialist Training Programme in Ophthalmology-

Checklist for July 2024 Intake

- Reviewed all guidance documents and scorecard on the ICO website prior to commencing application.
- Colour copy of current passport showing photo page.
- Verification of eligibility for the Irish Medical Council Trainee Division.
- Verification of Certificate of Naturalisation (if applicable).
- Verification of GNIB Residency Permit i.e. Stamp 4/ Stamp 4 EUFAM or IRPStamp 4 (if applicable).
- Copy of your Medical School Degree
- Copy of your transcript of results from your Medical School.
- Verification and evidence of your centile place within graduating class from Medical School
If your University does not provide a centile you must select the appropriate option on the application form and submit a letter from your College on headed paper which clearly confirms this.
- Verification and evidence of other relevant degrees (if applicable).
- Verification and evidence of academic distinctions and postgraduate examinations (if applicable).
- Verification and evidence of presentations, publications, case reports, audits and courses (if applicable).
- Letter of support from your supervisor for “work in progress” (if applicable).
- Two Reference Nomination forms
